ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

- Official transcripts from all academic institutions; undergraduate GPA of 2.5
- Minimum of three undergraduate science courses
- Official GRE or PRAXIS scores; TOEFL scores if your primary language is not English
- A statement of goals
- Two letters of recommendation
- Valid teaching certificate and/or rationale of intent for informal education



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
